Family Background: In addition to a brief family sketch, you should include information about any members of your family who are involved in the movement or are prominent in their community.

History...: This should include your first contact with the movement, first movement activities, and a summary of your work with the movement including any interesting or particularly important actions or projects in which you have been involved.

Personal History: This should include your schooling, interests, howes and anything else (incidents, activities, etc.) relative or not relative to the movement which might be of interest.

Comments: These should be remarks or statements made by persons involved in Civil Rights activity whom you have worked with. They should concern your work, personality or commitment to the movement.
