FUNDs of all sizes and amounts. Funds are needed for both general operating expenses; salaries of field staff(now being paid only every two weeks the small sum of 39.64) as well as for the Southern Wegro students who worked for SNCC this summer (some 100 of them) and who need scholarship subsidies in the fall (about \$300 each). These funds can be given tax-exempt. and checks should be made out to the National Council of Megro Women, and marked for scholarships.
