This does not rule out people leaving on the 16th, but it is important 2: that priority is placed on the earlier date.

Buses, and cars will be leaving from five (5) points in the State on September IIth. One city in each Congressional District has been chosen as the district departure point. They are as follows:

3rd District: Jackson 4th istrict: Meridian

5th District : Hattiesburg.

For those people who can only leave on the I6th, transportation will be available from Jackson. Buses will leave from Jackson and no other place on the I6th. However, if the FTP in any county is chartering its own bus, the departure date is up to the county exec.
