Selma: Tom Brown

Today were the trials from charges during Freedom Day period in October. All expect Tom Brown and Terry Shaw were convicted and fined \$300 kHd khtdkkhd with \$500 bhtth appeal band. All but Alvery Williams are out on bond (they had previously posted the \$500 as appearance bond.) Alvery has had a \$1000 peace bond placed on him and will be in jail until that is reised.

Terry Shaw is a juvenile and therefore his case has been transfered to juvenile court. They don't know when that will come up.

Tom Brown was originally charged with unlawful assembly. That was changed to contributing to the delinquency of a minor and he will be tried at a later date by Judge Reynolds (with Prathia and others).

Chico Neblett's trial was continued to March 5 (he was unable to get to Selma) along with three others. It is imperative that he kkkk appear on March St 5.

Judge Maryland was the presiding judge and ran through the taktat cases very quickly finding all guilty as charged (with above exceptions).
