That'd be great; if I come for such a short time I don't know what I'll do about seeing relatives etc, but we'll worry about that if I come. I would far prefer to stay with you most or part of the day, ~~party~~ go to the benefit, party that night, and leave it at that. Work is going so well, however, that I don't know if I'll be there q

I spent three days at Keinonia Farm, a religious community that has operated on an interracial basis for years. They were smeared communists, machine gunned at night, the works, around 1957. They have acres and acres of beautiful land, valley and hills, creeks, fields and pastures. I EVEN WENT HORSEBACK RIDING. I still can manage my own on a horse, to my surprise.

since I got back it's been run, run, run. We canvass every afternoon in Albany. Then the usual round of business. The last week I've been researching and mimeographing the Voter Registration Test for Sumter, Terrell and Lee counties, for illiterates. It has all kinds of questions on solicitor general, state officials, congressional districts, judicial circuits, etc.

I heard from Mr. Marienhoff of Music and Art today, wonder! He's the teacher who picketed in a Fairplay for Cuba line, that he would flunk the boy if he heard of his doing such a thing again. Just general support, regret that the administration hasn't done more, admiration. My goodness. He had heard that I was down here from Sherron, and gotten my address from her.

How are you feeling, Madre? That head doesn't sound like it's doing too well. Can't you take it easy for a little while longer? Glad your assistant is working out.

College next year — don't forget that the money I had to cover this term won't cover the fall term next year because I more than likely won't have a state scholarship, also, ~~no~~ tuition raise. I wrote the president of Barnard Student Council, asking about scholarships (Barnard or otherwise) that she thought I might apply for.

How's it going Chaisy? I guess your term is almost, if not already, over. Hope regents weren't too bad.

We have a Terrell meeting tonight, so I must run.

OH! The GORGEOUS package arrived. Thank you. We got a pile of canned goods from Phila. The stuff you sent will give us some needed variety. I didn't send the towels back, by the way, after thinking about it. They have been put to very good use right here. The rest is great, socks, book, figs, honey, WOW. thank you.
