IMPRESSIONS OF COMMUNITY:

I noted a similarity between people ( I met on bus on trip to Hattiesburg) and people I had met in Nazi Germany as a nurse there during World War II. Then it occurred to me that even the countryside between Jackson and Hattiesburg was similar to much of Germany. The thought was a startling one.
