John Dorr of the Justice Dept. spoke to us this morning and said himself that none of what the Miss. officials (Johnson, Eastland, etc.) said is true. This week has really been exhausting – rather like growing pains I guess – we're learning so much, experiencing the gamut of the emotions from tears to joy to tears several times a day, that it's like a great stretching of all one's capacities.

Could you please send me the following as soon as possible. I'll pay you for what you have to buy when I get home.

- 1) Sport equipment (something old around the house like a frisby and ball)
- 2) My typing book (Whiting Business School)
- 3) The de Souze French book that D and I used in jr. sr. high
- 4) The bio textbook from high school
- 5) A denim skirt (prob wrap around) with pockets
- 6) Couple pairs of petty pants

Thank you in advance.

Hope you are all well. We leave tomorrow, plan to arrive in Greenville Sunday a.m.

Please say a prayer for all of us. My stomach feels as though it's in my shoes and my heart in my throat. Have you been in touch with the Falks? Gail is going to Meridian (in the county where the 3 boys died).
