I understand that the following items may be created from my interview:

- an audio and/or video recording
- an edited transcript and summary
- a photograph of me
- copies of any personal documents or additional photos that I wish to share

I understand that my interview and other items may be distributed to the public by Interviewer or Institution for non-commercial educational purposes, including formats such as print, public programming, and the Internet.

I understand that a copy of these materials will be archived by Institution and that it will be made available to the public for research and educational purposes according to Institution's standard policies.

I agree to freely share my interview (and other items above) under the terms of a **Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike 3.0 Unported License**. This means that I retain the copyright, but that the public may freely copy, modify, and share these items for noncommercial purposes under the same terms, if they include the original source information.

In return Interviewer and Institution promises to send one free copy of the interview recording, transcript (if any), and related items to my address above.

Interviewer and Institution agree that if written transcripts of audio or video recordings are produced, Interviewer will provide Participant with a copy of the transcript if it is feasible to do so. Participant may review, correct, amend, or extend his or her transcribed remarks before the transcript is published, posted, or made available to the public, and only the revised transcript may be published, posted, or made available to the public.
