## Article Io Name

This Organization shall be know as the New Orleans Congress of Racial Equality, Ince, and shall be abbreviated as CORE.

## Article II. Purposes and Nature

The purpose for which this organization has been formed and for which it exists is to abolish discrimination based upon Skin Color, Race, Reilgion or National Origin, stressing non-violent, direct action methods.

> Article III. Membership

Any person who subscribes to the Purposes of CORE as set forth in the National Constitution and who is willing to abide by CORE Rules for Action and meets the requirements of the local group is entitled to membership.

Active membership shall not be available to any person who (a) associates himself with any other group or organization which expounds a philosophy which is inimical or in contradiction to the fundamental principles of CORE: (b) persisrently violates the CORE Rules for Action; (c) attempts to subvert the CORE group through allegiance to other groups or organizations.

The CORS group shall consist of active members, probate members and friends of CORE. A probate member is a person seeking full membership; a friend of CORE shall be a person who participates in demonstrations, tests and meeting. Or gives finical assistance, but dose not desire to become an active CORE member, an active member is a person that takes part in all CORE activities and meeting and desires to be an active member.

To become a member of CORE a person must (1) have been a probate member for (4) four weeks or a friend of CORE regulariy attending meetings and demonstrations for (4) four weeks, (2) be interviewed and instructed by the membership committee, (3) All person must be voted into the group by $2 / 3$ mojority of present and voting members of the group. (4) Attend (4) four regular CORE meeting and participate in at least four demonstrations, tests or negotiations. (5) Any person missing (3) three consecutive meeting without a voild reason ( subject to approval of the group) is automatically dropped from the rolls.

Only menbers of CORE may hold office. Only members may vote for officers and on questions involving (1) CORE Policy, (2) Amendments or changs in Constitution: and Bt-Laws, or (3) Take part in discussing of CORE Policy.

In matters involving direct action projects, all person who have been acceptec as participants by the CORE group or chosen by the Chairman as participants are entitied to vote on procedures, tactics, etc.; only active members may vote should the group consider that matter of policy are involved.

Membership may be revoked if threc mombers so request, and aftor a hearing by two-thircls of tho members of the nembership committee voting, vote for expulsion. Iny person so expellod may appeal within thirty days to the National Office for reforral of his casc to the noxt meoting of the National Council or Convontion of CORE.

Should any person be admitted to active membership by the local group and his mombership found to be in ccnflict with the RESTRICTION ON MQMERSHIP in the National Constitution or CORi's philosoply, it shall be neld that his admission was through error and therefore void.

## Article IV DUES IND FIN/NCES

The fiscal year shall begin on Junc lst, and end on the following May 3lst. los may bo pledged by each member or the finence conmittee may offer a plan wo the group to collect dues, which would be subjoct to the approval of twotliirds of the voting mombers.

Additional funds may be raised through fund appeals, donations, social and other acosivities.

Articl $V_{0}$ OFGIC.RS $A N D$ ELICTIONS
The officers of New Orlecns CORE shall consist of Chairman, Vice Chairman, Financial Sccrotary, and Corresponuing, Secretary. (Other officers may be added as the group grows and the noed arises.)

DUIITS OF THS OFFICERS
The Chairman shall preside at meetings and shall have the authority to appoint all committees, to appoint spokesmen for the group action projects, and to cast the dociding vote in the event of a tie. He shall be an ex-officio nomber of clll committees except the nominating committee.

The Vice Chaimm shall take over the dutios of the Chairman in the event of his absence. He shall perform such other duites as may be delegated to him by the Chairman.

The Secrotary shall take mirutes of meetings and keop a record of all CORE activitios.

The Corresponding Secrotary shall be responsible for all corrospondence and take over the dutios of the Secretary in the ovent of his absonce. He shall perform such other duties as may be dulegatod to him by the Chairman.

Tho Financial Secretery shall be rosponsible for kecping a financial record and making reports at rocular inturvals, for keeping dues rocords and collectin; dues frcm each mumbur, and for mintaining a bank account and issuing chocks. It shall be require that the Chairurn is to ersunturain all chocks also.

## ELIDCTIOMS

Notice of ulections must be sent to the mumbership at least two wooks before the said election, and two notifications are preforable.

A Nominating Committee appointed by the Chairman shall propare a slate of officers, Additional nominations may bo made from the floor. Blection shall be by socrot ballot. A plurality (majority) of votes cast shall constitute an olection.

There must be a quorum present before action can be taken on any matter which roquires the vote of active members only. A quorum shall consist of those prescnt at a regulerly announced meotine if it is at least $50 \%$ plus one $\jmath_{r}$ two thirds of the members in good standing at a specialy ealled meeting.

In the ovont an officc bocomes vacant it may be filled by appointment or Special Election. The Chairman with the agrooment of the Vice Chairman or the membership committee shall have the powor to make ssid appointment.

## ARTICLS VI. MSITIMGS

CORE meotinss are not open to tho public and only membors, probat members, friends of CORE and individunls invited by a mumbor have the right to attend. During discussion on Mattors invclving dircet action projects or CORE Phileoscpiny all persons not active members in good standing shell be asked to leave the room.

The distribution of political and /or roligicus litoraturo and the literature of other groups is prohibited immelatoly before, during, or imnediate?.y fitor CONE moetings and dumonstrations. Hcwever, any ruprescntative of another organization invited to speak befoze CORE may distribute the literature of the organization he represents.

ARTICLE VII NIENDMENIS
Notice oi' chan es in this constitution must be sunt to the mombership for two consecutive wc.ks before such changes are to be voted upon. Anondmonts shall be incorporated into this constitution upon approval by a majority of two thirds of the memburs voting.

## (AMENDI-AEITS) FUNCTIONS:)

An Executive Committee shall be formed. It shall be composed of all Officers. Cormittee Chairmen and two (2) person elected at charge.
