On this date (7/9/61) we received information that a groupea of people were comeing by bus from Montgomery Ala. to Jackson. These people calling themselves Freedom Riders, were on the Trailway's Bus due in at the station at 1:15 PM.

At 1:38 PM the bus pulled into Doc #8 and began to discharge passangers.

A groupe of (8) people discharged from the bus consisting of (7) White and (1) colored. As a groupe they walked down the ramp. A groupe of (5 white) went into the colored waiting room. A groupe of (3) went on to the White Waiting room, Consisting of Lula Mae White C/F, Lionel Goldbart W/M, & Stephen Greenstein W/M.

Capt John Ray approched the groupe of (5) that went into the Colored waiting Room and ordered them to move on. No one moved He then stated Move out of the station. Again no one moved. At this time Capt. Ray Placed them under arrest. They were escorted to the Paddy Wagon which was awating them in the rear of the station.

Capt. Ray then came to the White waiting room where the other groupe was He ordered them to move on, no one moved, Again he ordered them to move on out of the station. Again no one moved. ~~In the white waiting room the group~~

They like the other groups were escorted to the Paddy Wagon which was parked in the rear. They were brought to this Hqs. and placed in jail on charge of Breach Of The Peace.

Stephen Greenstein W.M. Age 22yrs. Address- 132, W. End Ave. Brooklyn N.Y. stated that he lives a Neighbor to Lionel Godbart, in Brooklyn N.Y. and they two got together and decided to come to Jackson with the Freedom Riders, he stated that they went to the Core Office in New York City and signed up to come, he stated that Core financed the trip for them, he is Married, he says that he is not a member of the N.A.A/C.P. or Core. has never participated in any Rides before this. He is a Truck Driver by trade.

This Boy talked freelier than any of the rest of the group that I, talked to, he told me that he left New York, with Four other Riders, on a Bus to Montgomery Alabama, and when they got to Montgomery, they were met by a Negro, name Tom Gaither, Tom, carried them to Rev. Abernathys house where they were Introduced to the group from Chicago, consisting of Mrs. Jeane Haerrick, and Lula Mae White C.F. and others he does not remember their names, he stated that part of them Six to be exact spent the night at Rev. Abernathys house and then the next Day which was this morning they all met again at the Trailways Bus Station in Montgomery Alabama, and boarded a Bus for Jackson.

Stephen Greenstein, stated that when they got off the Bus here in Jackson he and Lula Mae White C.F. and Lionel Godbart, went in the White waiting room

St. New York N.Y. stated that he was a History Teacher and had taught two years, he finished Columbia University, with a Bachelor of Arts Degree, he is of Jewish Faith, he is a member of the N.A.A.C.P. and Core, he came here from New York by Bus, Core, financed the trip, he has no previous Police record, this is the first time that he has participated in the Freedom Rides or demonstrations.

Lionel Godbart, W.M. Age 27yrs. Address- 130, W. End Ave. Rear Apt. Brooklyn New York; Stated that he finished Brooklyn College, and did odd jobs he is of Jewish Faith, does not belong to N.A.A.C.P. or Core, has been arrested once for Disorderly Conduct in Brooklyn N.Y. this is his first trip with the Freedom Riders, has never participated in any demonstrations, he volunteered to come down here to Jackson Mississippi, and spend Six months in Jail. Core paid all of his expenses down here.

Jeane Forry Hargett Herrick, W.F. Age 28yrs. Address-5515, S. Woodlawn Chicago Ill. Is Married and has Three year old Daughter, is of Unitarian Faith she is a student at Roosevelt University, studying Linguistics, she will not admit being a member of the N.A.A.C.P. or Core, she admitted catching Bus at Montgomery Alabama, to come to Jackson, she says that she expects to stay in Jail, the whole Six months if necessary. She volunteered to make the trip with the rest of the group, she stated that she paid her own expenses down here

Lula Mae White C/F age 22 Years Old Address: 5343 Woodlawn Avenue Chicago 15 Ill. and she did not tell us to much, she did not want to tell us because she think that we know why she is down here, and she stated that she did not think that it would do any good to tell us, she said that she left Chicago Ill. on the 7th. day of July 1961 by Bus, to Nashville Tenn. and got there at 11:45 P.M. Friday Night, and spent the night, and left Nashville Tenn. by Bus, Sat. to Montgomery Ala. and Sunday about 7:30 A.M. they left Montgomery Ala. to Jackson Miss. by Bus, she told us her Mother name was Wille Mae, and she was deceased, and her Father name
