WHILE THIS HAS ALWAYS BEEN A MATTER OF CONCERN TO MANY IN THE JOINT UNIVERSITY CENTER, RECENTLY AN INCREASING NUMBER OF INDIVIDUAL STUDENTS AND FACULTY MEMBERS, AS WELL AS CAMPUS ORGANIZATIONS, HAVE SPOKEN WITH AND WRITTEN TO THE MANAGEMENT URGING AN END TO THIS PRACTICE. HOWEVER, NO CHANGE HAS TAKEN PLACE -- ONLY TWO WEEKS AGO, AN INTER-RACIAL GROUP OF SCARRITT STUDENTS WAS REFUSED SERVICE.

WE, STUDENTS AND FACULTY OF SCHOOLS IN THE JOINT UNIVERSITY CENTER, FEEL THAT THE TIME HAS COME FOR FURTHER ACTION. WE ASK YOU TO JOIN US IN WITHHOLDING PATRONAGE FROM THE CAMPUS GRILL AS A STRONG REPRESENTATION OF OUR CONCERN ON THIS MATTER. WE SINCERELY REGRET THE NECESSITY OF THIS ACTION, AND HOPE THAT THE CAMPUS GRILL WILL SERVE ALL PERSONS REGARDLESS OF RACE, CREED OR COLOR IN THE NEAR FUTURE.
