OCTOBER 30 to NOVEMBER 2 - FREEDOM VOTE

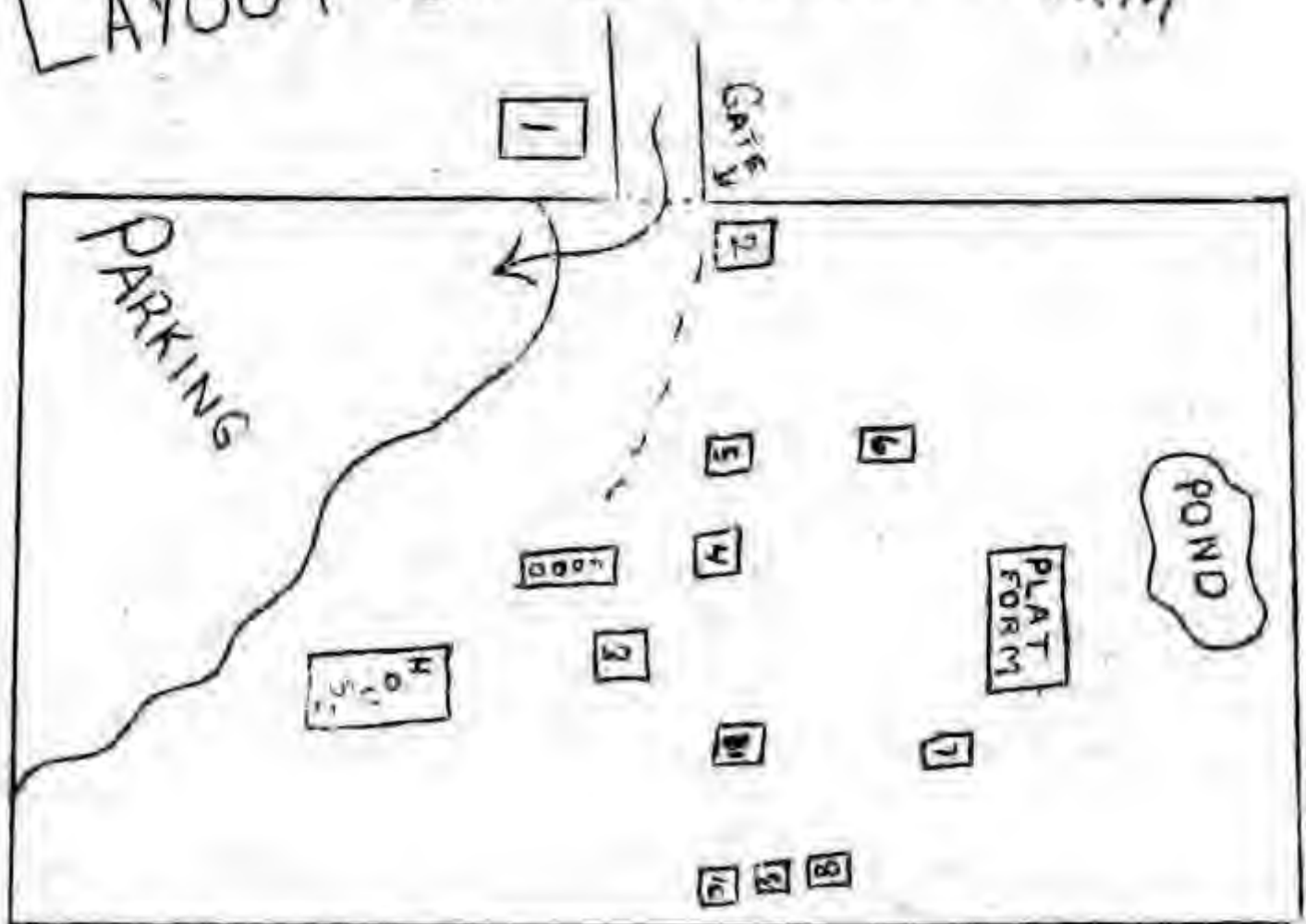
