THEREFORE -

Leaders of the Voter Registration Drive
have called for Wednesday, March 25 to be:

FREEDOM DAY

On that day, Negroes will
protest the fact that they
have been denied the right
to vote just because they
are Negro, and they will
demand their Constitutional
right to vote.

On FREEDOM DAY, we will go to the County
Courthouse to try to register to vote.

We will show the state, the
nation and the world that in
LeFlore County and Mississippi,
citizens are not allowed to
vote like other Americans,
just because they are Negro.

THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI HAS REFUSED NEGROES THE
RIGHT TO VOTE. WE MUST HAVE THE VOTE. THE
FEDERAL GOVERNMENT MUST PROTECT OUR RIGHTS!
