Enclosed is a copy of Joanne Grant's article from one issue about our field secretary in Ruleville, Mississippi. It will explain to you SNCC's reason for existence better than onything we could say.

SNCC's battle to bring civil rights to the South is intensifying. Money is needed now for some very down-to-earth reasons. Here are just o few:

- transporting Negroes from rural areas to register for voting;
- shipping food collected by northern supporters to sustain local people who have lost their jobs because of civil rights activity;

logol expenses for SNCC workers and local Negroes arrested on "traffic" and "trespass" charges,

 sending our field secretaries their \$9.64 weekly subsistence checks.

That's right: \$9.64,

Gur staff members live among the people with wham they work, at the same level. Mostly they live on air – and hope.

This is what SNCC aims for: a grass roots movement of human beings who persist in the face of hunger, horassment and real danger. But we need your help.
