ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 21, THE CITY COUNCIL OF CANTON PASSED A LAW MAKING IT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE TO DISTRIBUTE LITERATURE WITHOUT A PERMIT FROM THE MAYOR AND CHIEF OF POLICE. SUCH LAWS HAVE BEEN DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL BY THE FEDERAL COURTS.

THE OFFICIALS OF CANTON, IN AN ATTEMPT TO DESTROY OUR SUCCESSFUL SELECTIVE BUYING CAMPAIGN, HAVE PASSED THIS LAW IN OPEN DEFIANCE OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

WE MUST SHOW THE MAYOR, THE SHERIFF, THE CHIEF OF POLICE, ALONG WITH THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, THAT THEY CANNOT RIDE ROUGHSHOD OVER THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES, AND THAT THEY CANNOT FORCE US TO SUPPORT THE CITIZEN'S COUNCIL BY SHOPPING IN THEIR SEGREGATIONIST STORES.

IF WE WERE NOT WINNING THIS CAMPAIGN, THEY WOULD NOT BE HOWLING SO HARD. THEY WOULD NOT HAVE THROWN A DOZEN PEOPLE IN JAIL ON THURSDAY, AND THEY WOULD NOT BE THREATENING THE CORE AND SNCC WORKERS.
