
Re: letter of May 29th

Dear Ed,

I appreciate your quick reply to my letter. I would definitely be interested in coming, if you can use me at that late date. The reason I did not express interest in the "white community" part of your program is because, from the description, I have experience in all of the other areas excepting this one; I do not know what would be expected of me, and I, therefore, do not know whether or no I would be capable in such an area.
