- problems presented by factualism and scapegoating

- discussion of making an issue of Margie's being fired by Barney and Barney's threats to her and Bruce, his intimidation of Clarence and his poor working conditions

- agreement to demonstrate this issue

Margie and a group went to Barney's after the meeting along with three observers to see whether or not Barney would actually carry out his threats and thus test the validity of a demonstration around the issue. Barney was not around and everyone was served.
