Linda conducted a MSU meeting in the afternees.. about 30 attendence..discussed how to get more kids and adults involved in the struggle. Formed a committee to see about using the Masenic Temple for meetings....These same kids are mostly in the youth council of NAAGP, the only organization open to them to date. The MSU wants to continue through the schedl years doing CR work....

Freedom School conducted a rele play of the Dred Scott case and the abelitionists underground railroad.... 15 students participated..in the afternoom, special classes were held as usual..about 30 present.

Our pay phone was finally installed today ... h75-9069--it only cost us \$30. Mass Meeting in the evening.....300 attendence... oriented meeting around getting canvassers. The adults were timid, but the youth reled played canvassing scenes. The general COFO program was explained. Announced Freedom DP precinct meetings for July 26. Later there was a lot of participation from the audience..... Late in the evening, WVON from Chicage had a live radio program with Ren even the phone about the program, results etc.

Worked on Freedom Registration files. Convessin for people to attend prorver meeting of SCFO's tenight at First Emplist Church. Talked with reporter from local nonspaper "Chroncile" about the grend jury statuent that "Leadin Regrees testify dim't med civil rights workers.".....

Toung Negro girl from community was walking home from the store during the day, a white 1959 Honnovile with 5 or 6 whites drove by and threw several bobtles of beer at here, she was coriously hurt-could several times in the lower part of her back. Then taken to the hespital, no one waited on hercouthe was in deep pain..... Finally a local Negro GR gifl got the hespital Negro Dr. Merris to help hercothe white doctors generally refuse to help Negrosconthe police were there and wanted to know why the other girl was there. They showed no concern for the hurt woman only why the other girl was there. A witness to the incident was there and thred to give the details to the police. (The incident happened in News Point , the hespital is in Fascagoula so the Pascagoula police would do nothing....) The most point police tried to confuse the witness, but finally took down the information.......

Early this Morning, our local registrar was stopped by the Eurosgoula police and teld to come down to the police station muct Monday to talk to them. This has been happening to several people.

Barly this merning, a white man came by the office who works for Mayor Pierce of Noes Point and was interested in what we were doing. He seemed genuine. But some of us think he was sent.

Last might, two girl COPOers had to move. Fear is permeating the statespheres jobs are being threatened and lostessessesses

Our first newletter was writeen by Rom and distributed at the mass meeting. Freedom Registration forms were made up in lieu of the fact of not having my. The bus depot will not give us the paginges since we don't have the shipment papers.
