I and Mario R. Savio, were mittaix walking from the Farish St. 2 Church where COFO people eat lunch toward the COFO office 1017 Lynch St. We were on the when corner of Amite and Gallfitin. A gray car we pulled up and stopped in from of us. License number 501611 , a TAGE 1963 Mississippi, tag , blue letters on white background with county indication covered up. It was an old gray car. Ix Two white guys with billy clubs came out. The ginksxappearent clubs were dark and appeared to be regular police billy clubs. They were wood. They war appeared to be about 30, old clothes, informal. They were thin, and one was about 5' 9". They got out with clubs, We ran. They cameafter us. (by the way we were with a local Negro fellow who we had met at the church) .. We all three ran down the street. Robert David Osman and ran into the grASS at the side of the sidewalk; the Negro fellow and Mario R. Savio ran down the sidewalk toward the intersection. The Negro fellow got away without being hit at all. Savio was struck once a glancing blow as he ran. Osman who had some difficulty getting through the grass max rapidly enough was cut off in the alley by one of the men with clubs. The guy that was beating me beat me with a billy club at least eight hard blows. He wasn't saying anything. When they people ran over, he yelled "Let's get out of here" I couldn't stand up. It was realfy hurting me. Finally I was able to get into the McKesson/ building. They let us use the phone to call COFO and the police. The police came in about ten minutes. We MEXMENT were waiting for a return call from COFO in the McKesson building, but the police very rudly wouldn't let us wait. They said that the people in the building would not want us there. HannexHowever, the McKesson people were very cordial to us, letting us use the phone, etc. The police said to us when we reffered to the Negro young man who had accompanied us at first but who had already escaped by running of "We don't call them Negroes here, we call them niggers." Going down they said things like "When was the last time you guys took a bath". At the station, the police proceeded us up the stairs, saying "white people first". They repeatedly referred to "niggers". "Who was the nigger you were with/", etc. One pairs plainclothesman in the station referred to the situation as a "fight", apparently to make us appear to be also at fantly fault and to impair our position of nonviolence. Also, as we were driving down to the police station, I, askudathmaxequatifx(Osman) asked if we could smoke. The cops said no, and lit up themselves.
