I wrote to Ann Cook briefly last spring about NSM's educational materials because I was interested in them for the summer Freedom Schools. She sent me what she had on Negro history, Africa, booklists, etc. Now, however, we are extending the Freedom Schools into the fall and winter and our emphasis has changed. Specifically we are getting into tutorial programs, using the students' school materials as a base for teaching. Since you have been in the tutorial business much longer than we have, we hope you have materials which we could use. Besides curriculum materials for teaching, I would like to see what you have dealing with the tutoring process—teacher's guides, etc. Also anything else which you ~~think~~ think we would find useful and/or interesting.

If you would like, we will send you the stuff that we are developing, as soon as we can get it mass-produced. I'm pretty ignorant of what your tutorial program is like, but I hope that what we produce will have some use for others.
