

## MATERIALS NEEDED FOR MISSISSIPPI PROJECT

FUNDS of all sizes and amounts. Funds are needed for both general operating expenses; salaries of field staff (now being paid only every two weeks the small sum of \$9.64) as well as for the Southern Negro students who worked for SNCC this summer (some 100 of them) and who need scholarship subsidies in the fall (about \$300 each). These funds can be given tax-exempt and checks should be made out to the National Council of Negro Women, and marked for scholarships.

### SUPPLIES

#### I. Major Equipment

- A. Typewriters--preferably in good condition
- B. Duplicating machines
  - Rexograph
  - Mimeograph
  - Ditto
  - Photocopy types

Note: send the stencils, paper, ink, fluid, etc. that each kind of machine requires as well as the machine, please.

- C. Tape recorders (and recording tapes)
- D. Phonographs (and records)
- E. Tele-trainers (N.Y. Bell Telephone Co.)
- F. Film Projectors, screens and films
- G. Strip projectors and film strips.
- H. Blackboards, chalk, erasers
- I. Bulletin boards

#### II. Smaller supplies

- A. Paper--lined, unlined, poster, oak tag, graph paper, construction paper, rolls of newsprint, tracing paper, paper for duplicating machines, second sheets.
- B. Manilla folders and envelopes
- C. Pencils, crayons, pens, magic markers (especially red, black and blue), paints.
- D. Scissors, scotch tape, masking tape, paste, thumb tacks, paper clips, pencil erasers, mimeo correction fluid, chalk and chalk erasers.
- E. Stapling machines, staples, staple removers, pencil sharpeners.
- F. Stencils, mastercopies, ink, etc. for various duplicators.

#### III. Printed Materials

- A. Magazines; Life, Ebony, Jet, National Geographic, American Heritage, etc.
- B. Workbooks--all subjects and levels
- C. Maps--wall and desk size
- D. Artistic prints
- E. Official forms, such as social security, job applications, mail orders, etc.
