The New York Office has increased in 1964, its Fund Raising Activities FIVE times in comparison to 1963, however the expenses for the New York Office have only doubled. That is to say in 63 we raised \$69,184.80 and in 64 we raised \$363,443.78. Our expenses in 63 were \$9,888.65 and in 64 they are \$12,749.39.

Of the total amount raised this year \$46,702.47 was from Special Gifts. At these parties \$8,420.00 additionally was raised for the Educational Fund and \$587.96 in stock which is in Atlanta.

The Mailing brought in \$163,292.66 and the balance of contributions came from Concerts, Newspaper Ads Churches and Community activities. This amount comes to \$153,448.65.

In 1963 the New York Office sent \$35,553.98 to Atlanta while in 1964 we sent \$180,578.27. We have raised and paid for the radios in the cars in the south \$12,192.00, and we have opened a Savings Account of \$50,000.00 which draws 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ % Interest.

These are our figures up to October 1964, we hope to do twice as much in the coming year.
