Dear Friends of **McComb, Mississippi**

We were all gratified **39648** as I am sure you all were out there; with the outcome of the election this week, and the subsequent arrest of six more Pike County terrorists. The struggle for justice and equality in McComb, Pike County, and Amite County (which has one registered negro voter) is one which is steadily becoming more aggressive, and in which the various groups and individuals concerned are co-operating. Another Freedom Day in Magnolia is scheduled for Nov. 12.

With this mailing we would wish particularly to draw your attention, and we would hope, that of the nation, to the hearings of the Fifth District Federal Court in Biloxi beginning Nov. 16. Four days of court have been allocated for testimony by local people and civil rights workers. I have compiled, for reference, a partial list of incidents and related events of this year which seem relevant. Affidavits are being acquired for some of these incidents as well as for others. The Lawyers Constitutional Defence Committee, and in particular Marion Wright and Frank Jones will be responsible. The object is to obtain an injunction against the law enforcement officers.

I am also enclosing a copy of our newsletter, which Bill Powell is turning out every week now, and a plea for contributions for a sorely needed community centre here in Burglund.
