- (2) Go down to the county courthouse and REGISTER TO VOTE! You can register with-out having paid your poll taxes. And you can pay poll taxes without registering to vote. But you need to do BOTH in order to vote in the general election next November.
- (3) Pass the word to your friends, church, and clubs. Bring several friends with you when you go to the courthouse.
