The Medical Committee has asked that we notify them:

- 1. of any serious illness of or injury to a civil rights worker.
- 2. if any large scale demonstration takes place.
- 3. if any civil rights worker is jailed or needs documentation of police brutality.
- 4. if any health hazard such as open sewage ditches, wells near outhouses, etc. exist in the community

and that we make a report on:

- l. any friendly or unfriendly physician in the community.
- 2. discrimination with specific incidents involving physicians or hospital facilities in your area, including names, dates, etc.
- 3. any epidemic, no matter what its nature.

There is a WATS line in the MCHR office. If you want to speak to someone in that office, give the message to the State Office during your regular WATS call and we will have them call you - except, of course, in cases of emergency.
