This is a request for a contribution from you to be used by the Faculty and Students for Equality (FASE) to give financial assistance to civil rights projects both locally and in the South. FASE was organized last month to provide student and faculty representatives of the University of Wisconsin with a medium through which support of the civil rights movement can be implemented.

FASE funds will be used this June to support volunteer workers from the University of Wisconsin who are going south this summer under the auspices of The West Tennessee Project, The Southern Christian Leadership Conference (under the direction of Dr. Martin Luther King), The Congress of Racial Equality and The Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee. Volunteers with these projects will assist in voter registration efforts and education dealing with information about government and voting. In addition, FASE will support volunteers teaching students deprived of education in Prince Edward County Virginia during the school integration controversy.

The response thus far has been heartening —members of the UW Mathematics department alone have contributed almost \$400— but there remains a pressing need for more contributions. Conditions placed on contributions will be honored. Further information about FASE and the projects to be supported by FASE can readily be obtained from any FASE representative.
