And, if need be, the Legal Defense Fund is propared to file suits against violators of the act.

Unless the Negroes of this state are willing to go out and apply for jobs at plants that have discriminated in the past, or apply for promotion to better jobs, Title VII will mean ABSOLUTELY NOTHING!

RE: TITLE VII

The enclosed letter from Mr. D'Army Bailey provides opportunity for additional thrust in our efforts to put Title VII to work. CORE co-operation with the "INC" Fund in this regard can be especially effective in the following instances:

- (1) Where the demends of program already in operation make it difficult for local CORE to serve as anything more than a source of information to local persons or groups interested in working on Title VII.
- (2) Where the CORE or LCDC lawyers are unable, for whatever reason to work on Title VII cases.

Obviously, wherever CORE has the mechanics on hand in a community to proceed in these matters, we shall certainly do so. But not even both our organizations together have enough personnel to move through all the potential cases in Louisiana tat present. Therefore we can supplement each other whever the need arises.

Mr. Beiley will be in contact with us at various times and place according to his schedule. We will all have to work to derive the manimum benefit from those opportunities for mutual action which arise.
