IF THE VOTING BILL IS NOT PASSED BY MONDAY NIGHT, THE THOUSANDS WILL MARCH TO THE COURT-HOUSE TO DEMONSTRATE FOR ITS PASSAGE.

START MOBILIZING YOUR PEOPLE NOW --- RIGHT NOW !
