In view of possible developments in Washington - the possibility, for example, of Congress adjourning earlier than is generally expected (see Drew Pearson's article) - the Executive Committee is asking for as many people as possible to leave on September 14th, so as to be in D.C. on the 16th.

This does not rule out people leaving on the 16th, but it is important that priority is placed on the earlier date.

Buses, and cars will be leaving from five (5) points in the State on September 14th. One city in each Congressional District has been chosen as the district departure point. They are as follows:

1st District : West Point 2nd District : Greenwood

3rd District : Jackson 4th District : Meridian

5th District : Hattiesburg.

For those people who can only leave on the 16th, transportation will be available from Jackson. Buses will leave from Jackson and no other place on the 16th. However, if the FIP in any county is chartering its own bus, the departure date is up to the county executive committee.

There will be a STATE CONVENTION on September 12th, in Jackson, at the Masonic Temple. Time is 12.00. We hope that everyone going to Washington will be present.
