

SCHOOL TUITION LAW

Did your Child get turned away from School because he didn't have \$25 for fees? Hundreds did all over Mississippi.

This was because of a Mississippi law. It said all children not living with their parents, or legal guardians, had to pay school fees. The fees were \$25 a month, or more.

We think the law is unfair. We think that it was meant to hurt Negroes.

NOW, THROUGH a court decision, Mississippi officials are stopped from using this law.

THIS MEANS YOUR CHILD CAN GO BACK TO SCHOOL - IMMEDIATELY.

The Justice Department supported our thinking on the Tuition Law. About a week ago, the Justice Department requested Judge Cox to stop the State using the law - while the Courts decided if it was fair or not.

On Wednesday, October 13th, Judge Cox did this. He issued what is called a Restraining Order. The Order stopped Mississippi officials from using the law.

Anyone who was barred from classes because he hadn't paid fees, should now go back to school.
