TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

Said sponsor agrees to provide bail or bond to secure the release of the defendant volunteer from jail whenever he is arrested.

It is agreed that CORE is in no way liable for bail or bond at any time during the period in which said volunteer is affiliated with CORE.

TIME PROVISIONS:

The agreement becomes effective when it is signed by the sponsor and received at the CORE Southern Office at 2209 Dryades Street, New Orleans, Louisiana. The agreement is effective until August 31, 1965, at which time it shall automatically terminate unless extended by the agreement of the three parties involved.

The signed agreement must be returned to the CORE office within two weeks of the postmarked date on the letter bearing the agreement. If it is not returned within this time, the volunteer's affiliation with CORE

is automatically terminated. CORE is not liable for the volunteer's
bail or bond during the period prior to this agreement, nor is CORE
liable thereafter.
