Purpose of Workshop: To inform public of the Delta Ministry

The Delta Ministry is a 1½ year-old permanent commission of the National Council of Churches, which is composed of all major denominations in the Christian Church. The Delta Ministry is organized to change the low economic, health, and social conditions of Mississippi's poor. It is the first program in this country to be supported through the World Council of Churches by church groups on five other continents. Arthur Thomas is the national director of the Delta Ministry which now has centers in Greenville, Hattiesburg, McComb, and Cleveland, Miss. The Delta Ministry staff of fourteen is inter-racial and interdenominational, and works with volunteers and other civil rights groups.
