**Dear Cliff:**

**The Central Committee has decided to suspend all operations in Los Angeles pertaining to SNCC, and to ask that you submit your resignation.**

**The situation in Los Angeles was considered within the context of a general evaluation of all SNCC northern support offices. The sum of the evaluation of L.A. was that:**

- 1) You seem unable to organize effectively in the ghetto area of Los Angeles.**
- 2) That the pattern of your conduct as a staff person of SNCC has posed on several occasions, a threat to the organization, has wasted resources, and had a demoralizing effect on other staff members.**

**We acknowledge that the evaluation of your work was as much a personal evaluation of you as it was consideration of your program, with all the unclearness that that kind of (personal) evaluation implies.**

**You are invited to the next meeting of the Central Committee to discuss reconsideration of the decision asking for your resignation.**
