TRAINING INSTITUTE FOR TEACHERS, SUMMER 1965

The National Defense Education Act is offering federally supported summer institutes for advance study for teachers, supervisors, and specialists in public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools. The institutes are in English, Reading, History, Geography, and for school librarians, educational media specialists and teachers of disadvantaged youth. Participants will receive stipends of \$75. per week plus \$15. a week for eligible dependents.

Here is a good opportunity for teachers to obtain advanced training, thus making them better prepared to compete for jobs when the schools are desegregated. It will also enable them to improve the educational level of their present schools.

These institutes will take place throughout the country. April 15 is the DEADLINE for applications so we must work fast. If you have potential applicants, contact me immediately and I will send you information about applying to the institutes in your area.
