Holcomb-I talked to approximatly 30 households in the area beckered just west of Holcomb and just South of Holcomb. All but two of these families were former shareroppers who have had there land taken away in the last 2 years and are now just employed as day lzbor. This condition apparently is true for the entire Holcomb area. None of these people are withing eligable to vote is ASCS election. In this area we did locate 2 Negro families that owened there own land. they are-

Mrs. Lucil (7) Washington (marked El on map) (I did not have time to find out details of what she owns)

Mr/ and Mrs. Ash (marked E2) (did not get to talk to him either.)

Area Est of Gore Springs (around Pleaseant Grove Bap. Church (A whtie church). Most of the people who live in this area are Negro and most own there own land. We talked to three farmers in this area-

has over 15 acres in reserve.

Mr. & Mrs. Mac effic (B3) ownes own land. to scaired to talk any further as whites were there in a car. did get ASCS ballot
