1. Arrests at movie theatre-all charges dropped

2. Rrrest of Jim Bullock at Gity Hall -Jim was convicted and sentenced to 30 days.

3. Party arrests-All except Ron Gordon plead guilty and are waiting for bond money for an appeal. They are on probation untill appeal. Rons trial is the 21st. of July. LCDC may be going to file a suit about the excessive bail (\$1,000)

4. March Arrests (43) -As part of the injuction filed in Federal Court the ordinance that the marchers were **remarked** arrested on was declared un-constitutional. The lawyers expect that the charges will be dropped and the bail returned.

5. Arrest of Pauline Foxx-She is now out of jail but can not demonstrate. She was arrested on Juvenile Charges.
