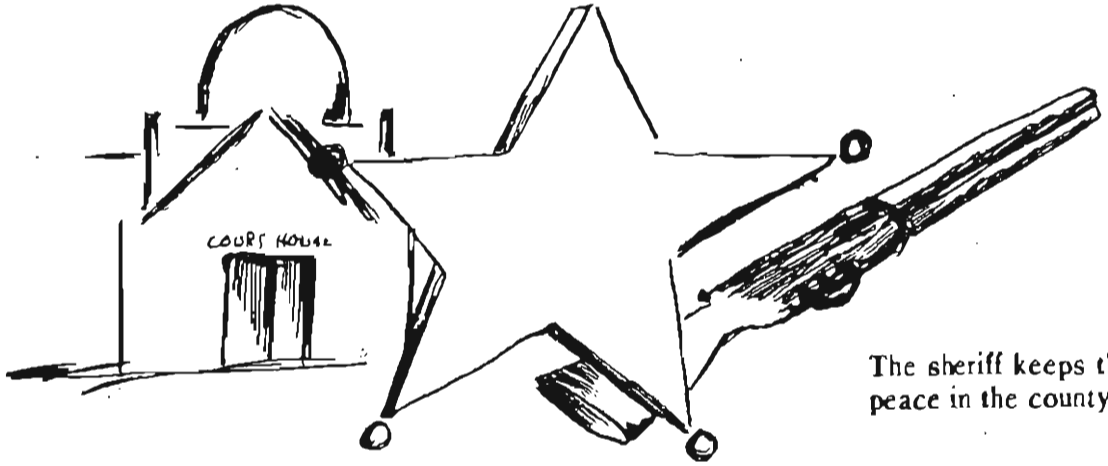

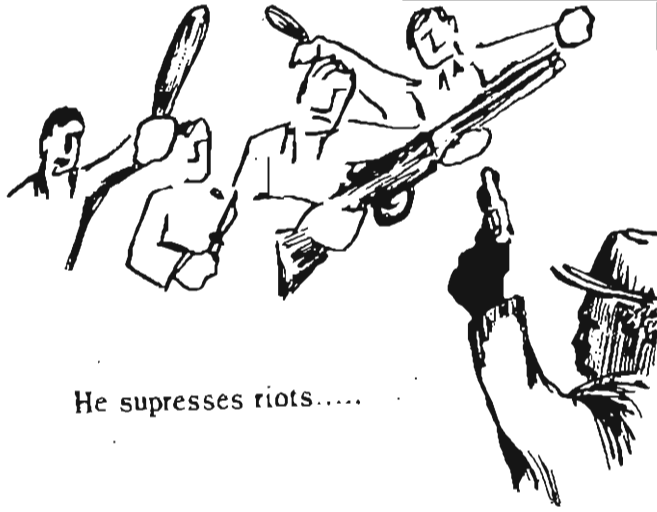

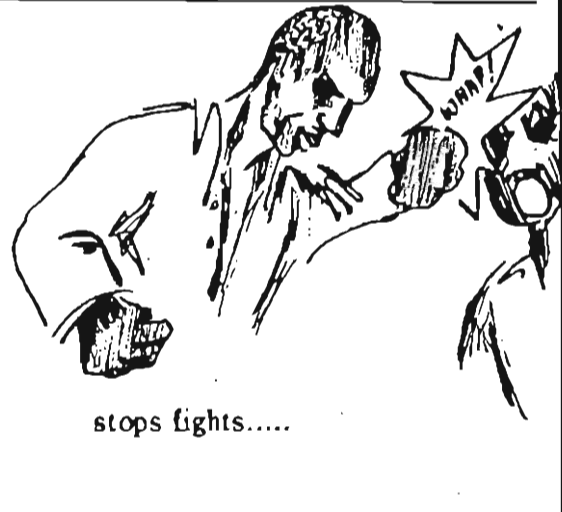

He supresses riots.....



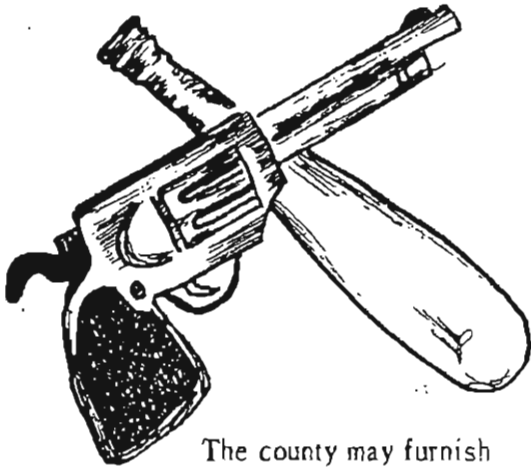

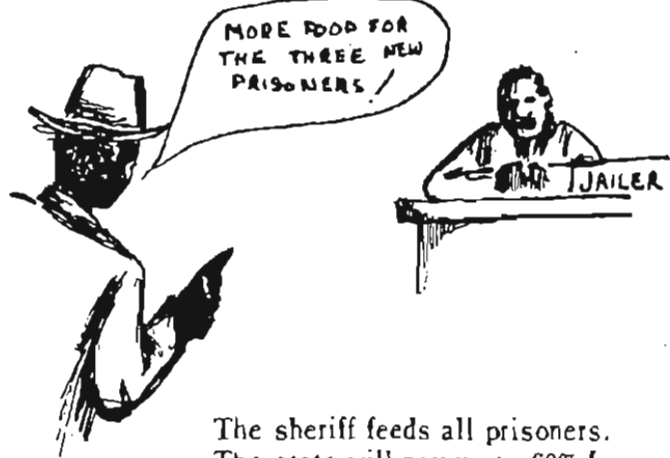

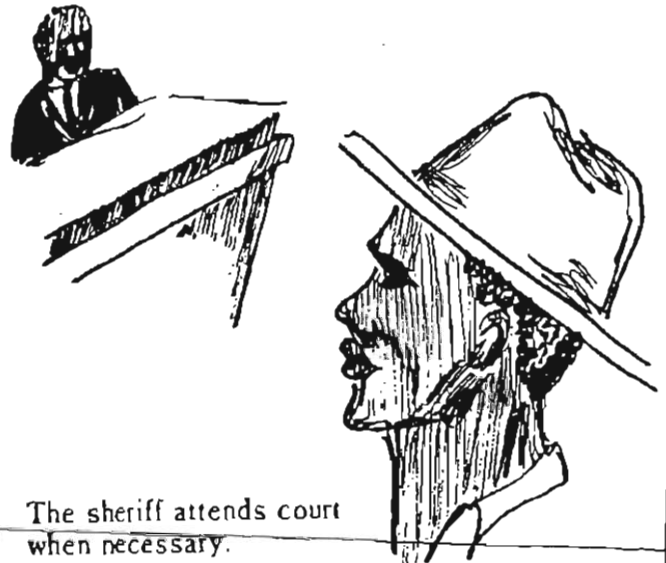
The county may furnish the sheriff with guns and ammunition for his job.



The sheriff feeds all prisoners. The state will pay up to 60% for each meal.



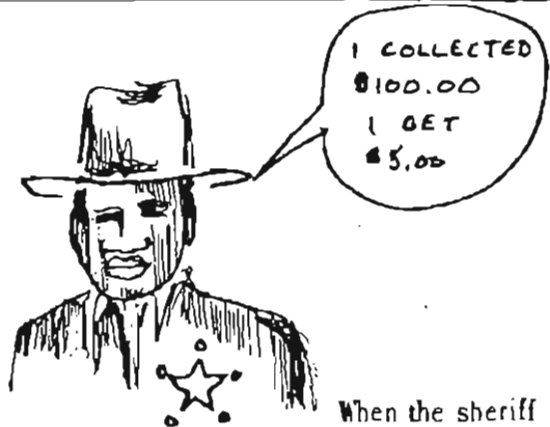
The sheriff delivers orders and subpoenas for the court.



The sheriff attends court when necessary.



He collects fines in the county for bootlegging, traffic violations, etc.



When the sheriff collects fines, he keeps 5% for himself.



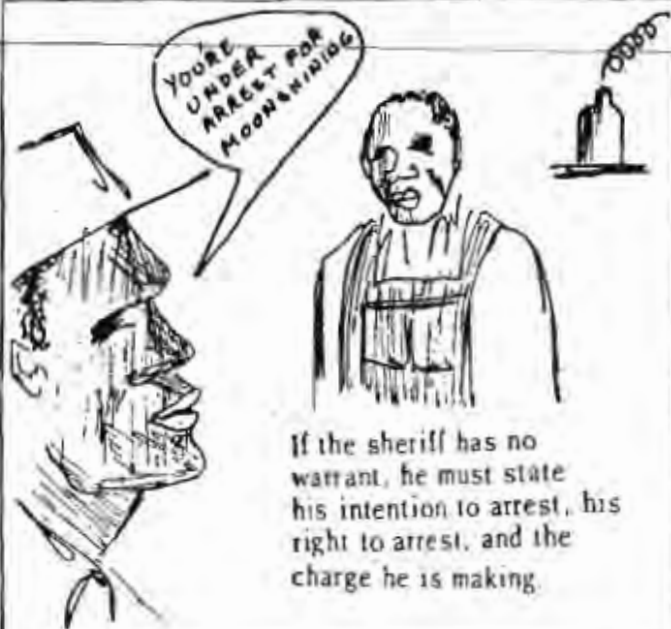
The sheriff investigates crimes, apprehends and arrests criminals.



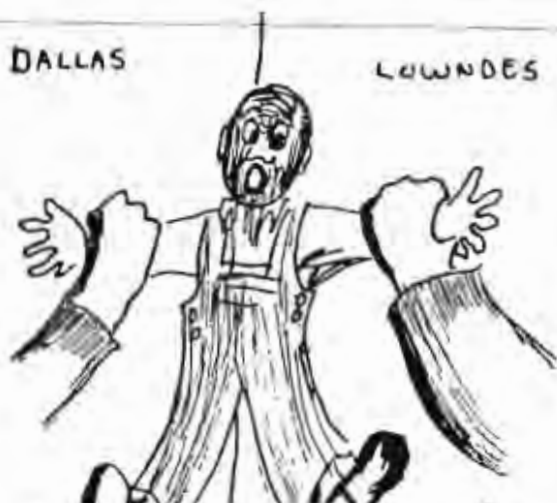
The sheriff can arrest with or without a warrant.



The sheriff can use force to arrest a criminal.



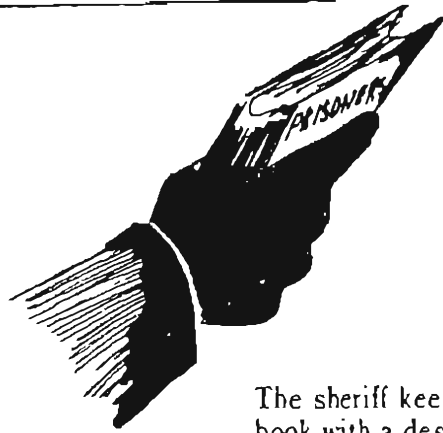
If the sheriff has no warrant, he must state his intention to arrest, his right to arrest, and the charge he is making.



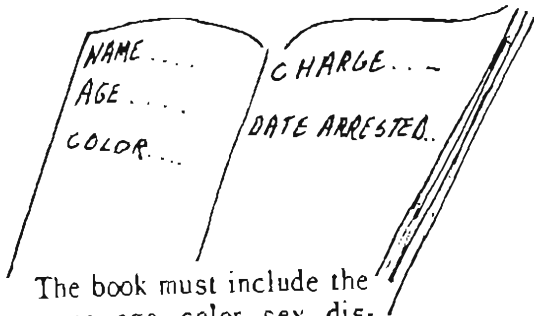
If the sheriff of Dallas County catches a criminal from Lowndes, he gets a removal order to return him to Lowndes County.



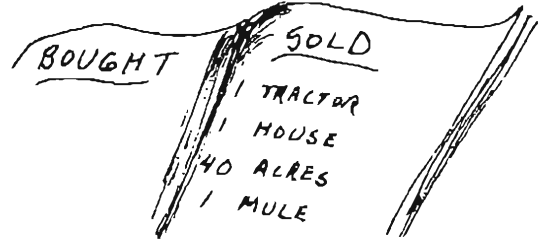

He gets \$2.00 for executing one at night.



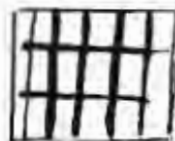
He gets \$5.00 for arrest in a misdemeanor or felony.



The sheriff gets \$2.00 for returning bond to court. He gets 75 cents for serving subpoena or notice.



He gets \$5.00 for summoning a jury to a special case.



The sheriff gets \$1.00 for putting a prisoner in jail.

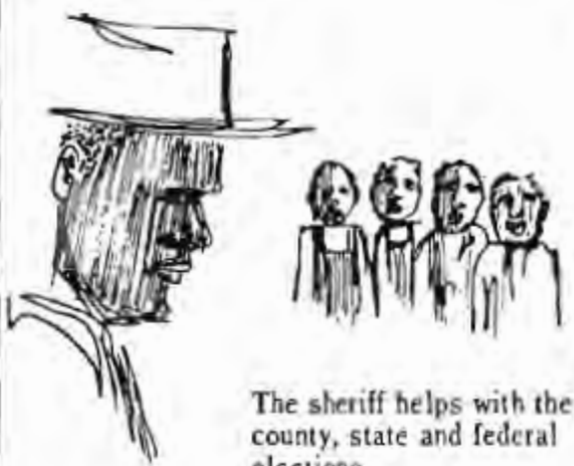
He gets \$8.00 for moving a prisoner from one county to another.

The sheriff must keep a record of all his work. He must file with the state to get his money.



The sheriff helps with the county, state and federal elections.



The sheriff probate judge and the circuit clerk are the election appointing board for the county.



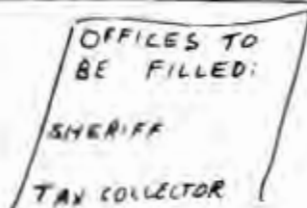
During elections they appoint three inspectors, two clerks and one returning officer to each voting place.



Those appointed must be registered voters.



The sheriff must list the appointments and put in the county newspaper all those who are inspectors at polling places.



The sheriff must give (30) thirty days notice in the county newspaper of elections and offices to be filled.



The sheriff puts a polling place for each three-thousand (3000) electors.



After the election, the sheriff gets the ballots that were cast. He keeps these ballots for six months after the election.

The sheriff sets the time for special election.



The sheriff and his deputies must preserve good order and must keep enough men to put down disturbances in all precincts.
