Information For Ushers

- 1. <u>Uniforms or Dress</u>: All ushers are asked to wear the kind of uniform or dress that they usually wear in their churches.
- 2. Identifying Insigna: All ushers will wear a sash prepared by the March Office.
- 3. <u>Demeanor</u>: Ushers are urged to practice the same decorum and sympathetic understanding as they practice in their churches.
- 4. Handling Problems: If some one gets out of order, boisterous, etc., immediately call for the help of a Marshall.
- 5. Ushers should be divided into groups of fifteen (15) with a Captain for each group.
- 6. Posts: Your post of service will be given you by your Captain.
- 7. Captains: All captains should report to March Office (North West Corner of Washington Monument Grounds) at 7:00 A.M., Wednesday, March 28th.
- 8. <u>Ushers</u>: All ushers should report at the March Office at 7:30 A.M.
- 9. Buttons, Pennants, Pledge Cards and Programs: Ushers will sell and distribute buttons, pennants, pledge cards and programs. Specific instructions will be given Wednesday morning.
- 10. At Lincoln Memorial: Ushers who serve at Lincoln Memorial will work directly under supervision of the Marshalls.
- 11. No sale or distribution of buttons, pennants, pledge cards or programs will take place after the main program begins at 2:00 P.M.
