

# SNCC NEEDS YOUR VOTE

Today in the South, students are playing a major role. They face constant beatings, jailings and, in many instances, their lives are in jeopardy. They are fighting for civil rights and freedom...not only their own freedom, but yours and ours, too... because no one is free until everyone is free.

The field secretaries for the Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee take time out, permanently leave, or are expelled from schools because of their civil rights activities. They are sacrificing their education so that the world we inherit will be a just one!

We students owe our Southern counterparts a debt and have a moral obligation to support their work. Voter registration activities cannot continue in the South unless the Northern supply lines are kept open. And it is in this regard that we can help...

Today and tomorrow (Thursday and Friday) Cal students have an opportunity to make a small gesture toward aiding the Southern students fighting for racial equality and social justice. We can vote to offer two percent (2%)--eleven cents (11¢) per student--of the ASUC budget to the Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee. This is a small amount--but it will help SNCC to do the work that we all should be doing.
