DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING said in Milwaukee on January 27, 1964:

"De facto segregation can be alleviated... Residential segregation must not be used as an excuse. Children must not be stigmatized as members of a caste system. I am in favor of demonstrating. It is a good weapon. It is a creative way to dramatize the whole issue. I strongly supported the boycott in Chicago... The problem of de facto segregation is a very serious one. The School Board must deal in an honest and forthright manner with civil rights leaders. It does itself a great injustice when it does not act with sincerity."
