BANK OF AMERICA TALKS BREAK DOWN

The negotiations which the CORE negotiating team has for some time been conducting with the Bank of America in San Francisco broke down this week. The negotiating team has asked all California CORE Chapters to begin action against the Bank of America this Friday, May 22nd. The Los Angeles CORE Executive Committee in an emergency meeting voted this week to join the statewide direct action. Ratification of Los Angeles CORE's support of the proposed statewide action must be made by the General Membership meeting this Thursday, May 21st. In view of the previously voted CORE actions, this is an important meeting. Please be sure to attend this meeting, listen to the facts, consider them with care, and vote accordingly.
