HELP? ----- HELP?

Millions of Americans are asking what they can do to help in the fight against the unGodly and unAmerican "Civil Rights Act of 1964". This is the bill that destroys private property rights, the American Free Enterprise System, and Constitutional government. If this unConstitutional bill is enforced, freedom and liberty will have ceased to be for our great America, and all our people... regardless of "race, creed or color".

Lyndon Johnson, years before becoming President, said that such legislation would destroy the American Free Enterprise System, and that such legislation, if enacted would, "...set up a police state in the guise of liberty".

Lyndon Johnson had the following to say about the "Fair Employment Practices Commission" section of a civil-rights bill, (as he stood in the United States Senate);

"To my way of thinking," he said, "it is this simple: If the federal government can by law tell me whom I shall employ, it can likewise tell my prospective employees for whom they must work. If the law can compel me to employ a Negro, it can compel that Negro to work for me... Such a law would necessitate a system of federal police officers such as we have never before seen. It would require the policing of every business institution, every transaction made between an employer and employee... I do not think the proposed law is workable... I am convinced it would do everything but what its sponsors intend." And Lyndon Johnson concluded, "I can only hope sincerely that the Senate will never be called upon to entertain seriously any such proposal again."

The above is Lyndon Johnson's honest, factual and sincere statement as to how the American Free Enterprise System could be destroyed.

At another time, Lyndon Johnson told that such "Civil Rights" laws (similar to the one he signed into law on July 2, 1964) would ruin America. Speaking in Austin, Texas, he said:

"This civil rights program, about which you have heard so much, is a farce and a sham-- an effort to set up a police state in the guise of liberty. I am opposed to that program. I fought it in Congress."

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

In your own words, wire or write The President, The White House, Washington, D. C., and tell him that you do not want your country and people under a police state, as set up by the "Civil Rights Bill" of 1964. Also, tell him that if The Pickrick and other places of business are closed by such an unAmerican and unGodly bill, that you will work for defeat of his administration in November.

Please make this protest to The President at the earliest moment possible. This is your way to help restore freedom to the American Free Enterprise System and private property rights. PLEASE GET YOUR RELATIVES, FRIENDS AND NEIGHBORS TO DO THE SAME. IN ADDITION, ASK THOSE YOU KNOW IN OTHER STATES TO JOIN IN THIS FIGHT.
