There are 3 calls to Washington (Theresa) and I call to Atlanta and 2 calls to Fort Atkinson. We haven't gotten it yet but when we do I will send it to you and you can pay me back O.K.

The packing was done on two weekends and most of it was sent through Glen Turner's library. Thank god. The only other emergency was a telegram campaign to Kastenmeier in support of the Freedom Party. Hence the 3 phone calls to Theresa to find out what it was that she really wanted. She is only a little disorganized. I've enclosed 3 receipts for contributions we have. There is 25 23.00 left in the account. That is not bad considering our expenses and the fact that at one point the arrount was down to 3.50. I thought you would have a heart attack over that so I rustled up some more.

Two things seem to be of first importance. One is the setting up of the book booth in Browns. I havent talked to them about it. The other is that a lot of people have asked about a clothing drive because of the change of seasons. Perhaps you should call Jackson or Treenwood and ask if they do need clothes. This is a good time because people switch all their odothes around. Chester has a few boxes stored at the World Affairs Center now.

I have left a girl named Kathy Wood in charge here in case of emergency. She was Jan's roommate. Her number is AL 7-1771 and she lives on Hawthorn Court. I've given her your name and number, my mothers number, and the mumber of the National office. I don't think anything will happen in the next week but you never can tell Steve will be back definately on the 8th. And Brad is here of course.

We leave Monday so I have to pack this weekend. Talk to a man named Don Stewart when you get back. He is organizing an Adopt a Freedom worker movement among the faculty. He was in Mississippi during the state convention of the Freedom Party. He is on the faculty in the computer lab in the social sciences building.

My address after Mon. is 61 Arbour Glen. I'll keep in touch. I feel like I have forgotten something but if I remember I will let you know.
