MEMORANDUM: HUAC Appropriations & Contempt Citations
Summary of work done by Chicago Committee

The following items, which are concrete and statistical, do not include a great amount of work, such as countless phone calls, assistance to defense groups (of subpoenaed persons), assistance to and work with the National Committee to Abolish HUAC (Washington & Los Angeles offices); nor does it describe the hours spent in building a current mailing list of opinion makers in each Congressional District.
