HOW LONG CAN THE U.S. GOVERNMENT BE HYPOCRITICAL LIARS TO BLACK PEOPLE AT HOME AND ABROAD

PRESIDENT JOHNSON has eaid; "The foreign policy of the United States is rooted in its life at home-----And we will not support policies abroad which are based on the rule of minorities or the discredited notion that men are unequal before the law."

THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT AND AMERICAN INDUSTRY supports this South African racist government with money. WE DEMAND that the United States Government stop verbally condemning South Africa while they physically and materially support them. We must have economic sanctions against the K I L L E R Government of South Africa N O W !!

BECAUSE the struggle in Africa is in a larger sense, part of the universal struggle of all non-white people, to obtain equality, WE in AMERICA, who are committed to the doctrine of "Black Power," demonstrate in support of our BKOTHERS in AFRICA so that on that continent too, "Black Power: will become a reality. "Black Power" has as its end, the achievement of control and dominance by Black people of all countires and territories where they constitute the majority.

TO THE U. S. GOVERNMENT AND TO THE PRESIDENT we say: Practice what you preach; at home and abroad !!

AS AMERICAN CITIZENS WE DEMAND:

- 1. That the American Government take immediate steps to end all economic, military, and political intercourse with South Africa.
- 2. That the United States actively pursue, in the U. N., the imposition of multilateral sanctions against South Africa.
- 3. An End to Black deaths in Viet Nam, while America woos the white racist Government of Enric Vorwoord, which suppresses the aspirations of twelve (12) million black people.
- 4. That Black soldiers be withdrawn from Viet Nam and be used to fight for Black majority Government in South Africa and Rhodesia.
- 5. That the United States Government, with the support of African and Asian Nations, seek to abolish the World Court which has proven itself ineffective in dealing with the problems of black people throughout the world.
