INSTRUCTIONS FOR PICKETS

Check in at <u>WALKOUT CENTRAL</u> for assignments to picket areas, and last minute instructions. (Dwinnell Plaza)

- 1. If this is to be an <u>effective</u> walkout, we must have many people on the lines all day. Stay on the line as long as piceting lasts.
- 2. If anyone asks you for your reg. card, tell him to speak to the Captain of the line. If he persists:
 - a. Ask to see <u>his</u> identification as a "representative of the university"
 - b. Show him your reg. card, but <u>do not</u> surrender it (note wording on the card itself.

b. Report his name to the line captain IMMEDIATELY.

- 3. If gentlemen of the press approach you on the line, send them to the line captain for comments.
- 4. Try not to block anyones passage. We keep people out by moral, not physical, strength.
- 5. Jeering and name calling increase hostility and prejudice uncommitted people.
- 6. Dress well, be as orderly as possible, and follow the instructions of the line captain.
