

Where Do We Go?

One of the purposes of the Black Power Conference has been to stimulate new ideas and discussion as to where The Movement at Berkeley will go from here. Black Power offers a challenge to white radicals to organize themselves.

Workshops are planned for the day after the Black Power Conference, which will begin to discuss these problems concretely. The workshops should allow for maximum flexibility and "self-determination" and, at the same time, attempt to focus on substantive and programmatic issues.

HELP PLAN THE FUTURE OF SDS

The workshops will be divided into two sessions. From about 1 to 3 P. M., people may want to orient their discussions around the general topics: "How do we stand now?" and "Where do we go from here?" By the end of the first session, people should have focused on a more specific topic; that is, "How do we get there?" Some may want to discuss specific anti-war and anti-draft activity, or campus organization, or S. D. S. structure or long-range perspectives for S. D. S. The decisions of each workshop on what they will discuss during the second session (3:30 - 5:00 P. M.) will be posted during intermission. In this way, continuity between sessions will be maintained for each workshop, but some individuals may switch to another workshop which they find closer to their interests.
