

# The Call

Ella Baker scanned newspaper accounts of sit-ins for names of people to invite. She contacted people with whom she had worked and wrote to heads of student bodies. Rev. Doug Moore of Durham toured North Carolina and Virginia urging demonstrators to send representatives. James Lawson and the Congress of Racial Equality contacted activists. In the end, there were over 200 participants: 126 student delegates from 58 communities across the South, representatives from 19 northern colleges, and observers from the Fellowship of Reconciliation, CORE, the American Friends Service Committee, the National Student Association and the YWCA.
