On December 31st, y'all recieved a mailing from C.A.M.P. entitled "The Christmas Bombing and the G.I. Movement". Part I of that mailing dealt with a request by the Vietnamese to recieve information about actions against the bombing resump-tion. It was suggessted that Y'all should send information to this office(U.S.S.F.) C/o Cora Weiss.

In a time when things move swiftly, especially when there is a great distance seperating you, misinformation and confusion can easily develop.

Part I of the C.A.M.P. mailing is a result of this kind of confusion. Both C.A.M.P. and us here in N.Y. were getting information from many different sources about things goeing on in Paris. Much of this information was contradictory. C.A.M.P. and U.S.S.F. were in communication at a point when things were still developing and we both commented to each other since a better way of handeling the kind of information we often recieve.

The nitty-gritty of all this is that: 1) The Vietnamese have never inquested the kind of information indicated. This does not mean they are not interested, just that a formal request was never made.

2) Neither Cora Weiss nor U.S.S.F. should be considered the offic~~al~~ or best avenue for channelling information to the Vietnamese, either in Paris, Vietnam, or anywhere else.

If people wish to pass on information about demonstrations to the Vietnamese, they can send it directly to their information office in Pzris.

We hope this letter does not cause too much confusion on your part. We felt we should just try and clear it up from a ~~prx~~ practical end so that the misinformation would not be spread any further. There was certainly no conscious attempt on any body's part to mess things up and confuse you. We'll try and make sure something like this doesn't happen again. One other thing should be absolutely clear, and that is that C.A.M.P. was not responsib~~l~~ for the fusk up.
