Selma Times Journal tonight: "The Sheriff's Dept, has ordered the arrest of Rev. # Benny Tucker,"21, SNCC worker, student at Selma University, a Negro Baptist college here. "The Dept said they were holding a warrant for his arrest on charges of contributing to the delinquency of a minor."

Rev. Tucker will stay in the 1st Baptist Church all night, seeking sanctuary, and Worth will stay with him.

Worth: "Selma is an armed state. Everywhere you go you see Alabama state patrolmen, the Sheriff or his 300 odd man posse, or city police. Hundreds of cars are packed with police. We have just seen two cars drive by (one without a license) with rigles, just as the mass meeting started."

Worth: "With 19 arrested the student strategy committee says we can't trun back. They say 'We'll intensify efforts now regardless of Lingo, Sheriff Clark or even Wallace himself. How can we stop now?","
